

# ST. MARY'S CHURCH, CHADDESSEN GRAVES PLAN AND LIST

## INTRODUCTION

The churchyard surrounding St. Mary's Church in Chaddesden was first licensed for burials in 1347 during the reign of King Edward III, and down through the centuries it has been the final resting place of perhaps some 5,000 or so villagers, only a small proportion of whose graves were ever marked with any kind of permanent memorial. In much more recent times, anyone familiar with St. Mary's Church in the late 1970s will probably remember how overgrown the churchyard was, despite the valiant efforts of a small team of volunteers who always seemed to be fighting a losing battle against the vegetation. The problem lay with the fact that it was virtually impossible to get a petrol-driven mower over the grass because of the huge number of marble kerbstones that were scattered here and there.

The Parochial Church Council (PCC) eventually debated this state of affairs and decided to investigate the possibility of removing the majority of the kerbstones. The first matter that needed to be addressed was the lack of a plan showing all the marked graves. I volunteered my services and in the summer of 1981 many visits to the churchyard ensued as I tried to reach and note the position of every single grave, in some cases hacking back the grass and weeds before I could even get to a particular stone! Next, the PCC had to decide exactly which kerbstones needed to be removed and in due course the church's intention was duly advertised in the local press. A small number of people came forward as a result of this and indicated they wished their relatives' stones to be left untouched. Eventually, in March 1983, the PCC obtained a Faculty or formal permission from the Diocese permitting the removal of approximately 90 sets of kerbstones. Now the problem was finding someone to undertake this extremely labour-intensive work. Fortunately the Derby Community Task Force agreed to provide the manpower and between December 1983 and May 1984 a team of men worked hard at removing the heavy kerbstones, making good the surface and generally levelling out some of the worse humps and hollows in the churchyard as well as repointing sections of the churchyard walls.

All this effort certainly paid dividends, for the churchyard was now significantly easier to maintain, and in 1984 with access to the gravestones greatly improved I had the idea of making a much more detailed survey of all the memorial stones and their inscriptions (including those recently removed) as a permanent record. From the summer of 1984 and well into the next year I photographed each individual stone and typed all the dates and inscriptions into a book, copies of which went to Derby Local Studies Library and Derbyshire Record Office. In 1992, the PCC petitioned HM Privy Council to declare the churchyard closed for further burials under the provisions of the Burial Act 1853. This was duly approved in early 1993, and shortly afterwards the responsibility for looking after the churchyard i.e. cutting the grass and maintaining the boundary walls, etc., was transferred from the PCC to Derby City Council as the appropriate local authority.

This article is intended to make versions of both my plan and survey available to anyone who has a particular interest in St. Mary's churchyard, whether they are trying to locate the whereabouts of a relative's grave, tracing family members as part of genealogical research, or engaged in general historical study. To keep the amount of data to a manageable level, I have not attempted to include any other details that might feature on a particular memorial other than an individual's name, year of death, and age.

## THE PLAN

The plan reproduced below gives a greatly simplified layout of the graves with the various rows (e.g. 1A – 10, 11 – 18, etc) indicating the approximate locations of the plots. In practice, these rows are frequently not as well defined on the ground as they are on the plan and there are sometimes considerable gaps between one grave and the next, especially towards the east end of the churchyard. Nevertheless, by using the plan together with the list of the graves and a little bit of patience it should be possible to locate a particular plot relatively easily.

In addition to the main sequence of marked gravestones, two further sets of memorials are also to be found in the churchyard. In the 1970s a dozen or so broken gravestone fragments were piled in a haphazard fashion against the south wall of the church, so they were moved alongside the hedge at the west end of the churchyard, where they remain to this day ... on the plan they are shown as "Fragments A – I". By the late 1980s various small commemorative stone plaques had begun to be fastened to the south wall of the churchyard; however, this wall was completely rebuilt in three phases between 2009 and 2016, and although some of these small tablets may still be seen lying on the ground in the position marked "Wall Plaques" on the plan, others appear to have vanished.

Visitors to St. Mary's Church may also spot the small plaque fixed to the notice-board indicating that there are Commonwealth War Graves in the churchyard, both of which (i.e. 123 and 194) are numbered in with the main sequence and date from the 1940s.

## THE GRAVES LIST

The list on the following pages provides brief details of each memorial stone taken from my survey of the churchyard in the 1980s. It must be stressed that the list only refers to those graves which were then marked with a memorial of some kind. As mentioned in the introduction most of the graves were never provided with a permanent marker of any description, and since the burial registers seldom give the location of an interment the precise whereabouts of the majority of those buried in the churchyard remain unknown. The original survey on which this list is based was last fully updated twenty years ago, however, I have tried to ensure that any changes made since then have also been included. Unfortunately the passage of time will certainly have wrought changes to the condition of the memorials since I first recorded them – some will no doubt be even more illegible and inevitably others will now be broken.

The list is comprised of four columns as follows:

**GRAVE:** The reference number of the grave.

**NAMES & DATES:** Details of all those mentioned on the memorial, including the year of death (but not the month or date), with their age shown in brackets. An entry such as "(-)" indicates no date and/or age was given. Entries on a memorial stone giving the deceased's age in the style "in his Nth year" have been interpreted as the equivalent to an age of N-1 years. It is worth noting that not everyone mentioned on a memorial was necessarily buried in the churchyard ... sometimes a relative's name might be added to an existing stone after burial or cremation elsewhere.

**MONUMENT:** To keep the list as simple as possible, the various types of churchyard memorial have been classified into just four main categories as follows: Head = Headstone; Kerb = Kerbstone; Flat = A horizontal stone; Tomb = A tomb-like structure. The "Head" category is particularly wide-ranging and covers everything from a large headstone perhaps five feet tall, to a small upright stone maybe a foot in height, or even a simple cross or flower-holder.

**REMARKS:** Any other pertinent information is shown here. Kerbstones removed in December 1983 are identified and, in the case of burials prior to 1904, any significant (i.e. more than one year) variation from the ages given in the burial register indexes made in 1969 by Mr. E. J. Wheatley have been noted. In those cases where the original memorial consisted solely of an inscribed kerbstone that was removed in 1983 the grave will now of course no longer have a marker of any description.

## SEARCHING THE LIST

Since the list forms part of a PDF document, it is relatively easy to search for a particular name on an ordinary computer ... simply press and hold the CNTRL (Control) key and then press the "F" key and a small box will appear on the screen, into which the name can be typed and the computer will locate all relevant entries. A slightly different procedure is needed when using a tablet. Do bear in mind that the spellings are taken from the actual memorials and could well vary over the years.

To conclude this article, it is worth mentioning a noteworthy event in the churchyard's long history which occurred only comparatively recently and can be seen in the photograph below.



**Rededication service of the memorials to Sir Henry Wilmot V.C., his wife and his sister, Wednesday 15 May 2013.**

In September 2010 the Nottingham & Nottinghamshire Victoria Cross Committee, originally formed to restore the memorials of VC holders in our neighbouring county, approached St. Mary's Church about the possibility of repairing and refurbishing Sir Henry Wilmot's monument in the churchyard (no.201). Sir Henry was awarded the Victoria Cross for an act of bravery in March 1858 during the Indian Mutiny and was laid to rest in 1901 in the southernmost of three conjoined plots (201–203) alongside his wife and sister. With the church's approval the VC Committee began to raise the necessary funds for the project and were eventually able to commission a firm of memorial masons, who removed all three monuments so they could be restored in their workshops. Once the work had been completed and the three memorials reassembled, a well-attended service of rededication was held in the churchyard on 15 May 2013 to mark their return to Chaddesden.

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
