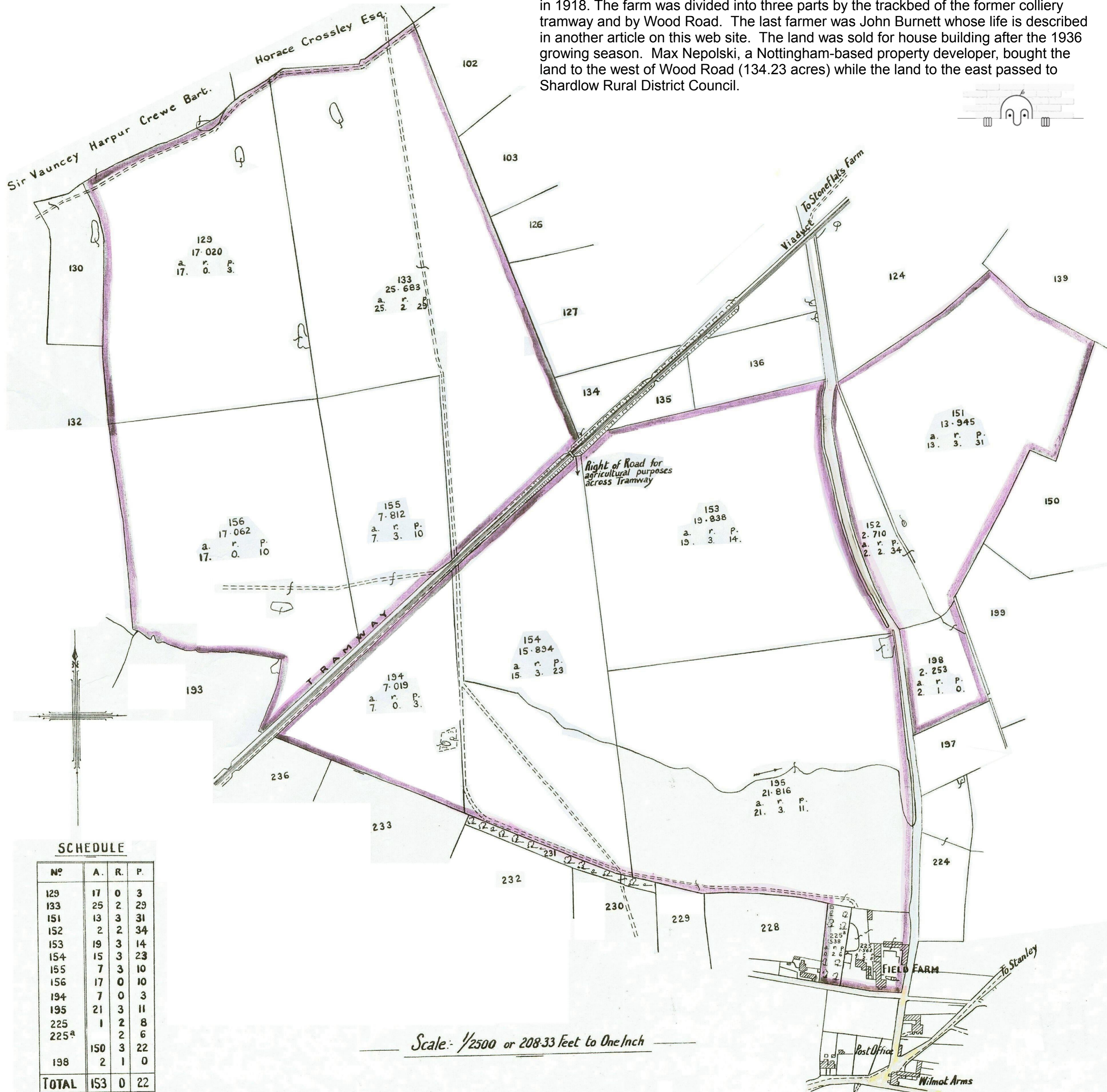


This map shows Field Farm as it was following the break up of the Chaddesden Estate in 1918. The farm was divided into three parts by the trackbed of the former colliery tramway and by Wood Road. The last farmer was John Burnett whose life is described in another article on this web site. The land was sold for house building after the 1936 growing season. Max Nepolski, a Nottingham-based property developer, bought the land to the west of Wood Road (134.23 acres) while the land to the east passed to Shardlow Rural District Council.
