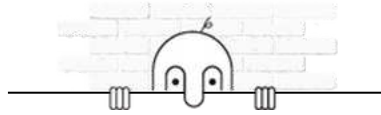

SCALE OF CHARGES.

ARRANGEMENT OF STOCK, and RECORDS.

FACEPIECES ready for issue are kept in labelled boxes on the large table.
Contents of each box are shown on the lid, and any alteration to the contents of a box should be recorded at the time on this list.

ASSEMBLED RESPIRATORS ready for issue are kept in the cupboard under the telephone.
~~Stock lists of all these articles are kept near by.~~ ^{hanging inside cupboard}
~~Alter at the time of addition or removal of any item.~~ ^{door.}

BABY HELMETS, when in stock, will be kept in their boxes and will carry a label showing whether ready for issue or requiring sterilising. Change the label (from stock in this file) if the state is altered by you. (e.g. by sterilising.)

FACEPIECES FOR STERILISING are kept, assembled in groups of similar size, in convenient boxes or situations.

DAMAGED, etc. GOODS FOR R.C. are kept in a box set aside for this purpose. Please add any faulty items received by you to this box, altering the contents list accordingly, ~~after recording on the appropriate G.P. form.~~

Civilian Respirators for Evacuees.

I understand that a number of evacuees from London and the South of England who have recently been billeted in this County have not brought with them their civilian respirators and instructions have now been received from the Ministry of Home Security Regional Office that respirators may be issued to these evacuees free of charge on application, providing a signature is obtained for the respirators by you and the old and new addresses of evacuees are ascertained.

A signature should be obtained on the buff respirator replacement form for all respirators issued free of charge to evacuees and the old address and the present address of the evacuee should be entered on the form, which should be endorsed "Free Issue to Evacuee".

Please ensure that the necessary arrangements for the issue of respirators to evacuees in your area are put into operation forthwith.
